- 10:00 Jubilee Audience with Pope Francis.
- 12:00 Lunch break (free).

Saturday, 22 October - Paul VI Hall - Concert

- 16:00 Entrance into Paul VI Hall from Piazza del Sant'Uffizio.
- 17:15 Rehearsal.
- **18:00** Concert led by the Diocesan Choir of Rome and Symphony Orchestra, directed by Mons. Marco Frisina, with the participation of all the choirs present.
- 20:00 End of the Concert.

Sunday, 23 October - Saint Peter's Basilica - Holy Mass

- **07:45** Participants meet at the white gazebo in front of Castel Sant'Angelo and begin the pilgrimage to the Holy Door of Saint Peter's Basilica.
- **10:00** Assignment of seats in Saint Peter's Basilica (according to voice parts) and rehearsal of the songs for the Eucharistic Liturgy.
- **10:30** Holy Mass celebrated by S.E.R. Mons. Rino Fisichella, President of the Pontifical Council for the Promotion of the New Evangelization, with music provided by the Diocesan Choir of Rome together with all the participating choirs.

Sunday, 23 October - Saint Peter's Square - Angelus with the Holy Father
